CHANGEMAKER INITIATIVE

The Changemaker Initiative enables people to donate their change in a contactless alternative way that requires less work from parents than traditional school fundraisers! This unique fundraising program promotes giving, leadership and 'making change' in our school community.

We are excited because it is an EASY and CONSISTENT way to raise funds, and it also encourages our students to be CHANGEMAKERS in their community. Becoming a Changemaker is simple: sign-up a credit or debit card, shop anywhere and impact our school. Each transaction is rounded up to the nearest dollar.

The change is then donated to the Academy at the end of each month. Flexible control also allows Changemakers to set an upper limit, donate to more than one student, or cancel any time. The STRIPE platform used by Amazon and other online stores ensures a safe and secure interaction.

PRESCHOOL MOVE UPDATE

Preschool Bible Time Joins Laramie Christian Academy

Preschool Bible Time, previously located at Calvary Laramie, has been working throughout this semester to move to the Laramie Christian Academy facility.

With zoning approved through the City of Laramie, the preschool will begin holding classes starting April 19th, in the mornings for 4 to 6 students Monday-Thursday through the end of the school year.

Starting next fall, Preschool Bible Time will expand into full-day program offerings. Families wanting preschool classes will have the option of full-day and half-day programs for 1 to 5 days per week.

Preschool Bible Time is approved for state of Wyoming Child Care Subsidy for parents who need childcare to work or attend school.



Our full-day program will have the same hours as the K-8 Academy – 8:15 am to 3:30 pm. Watch our Facebook page and website for further details on tuition.
