LCA OPENS ENROLLMENT 2022-2023

FAMILIES SEEK EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

Laramie Christian Academy opened enrollment for the 2022-2023 school year mid-January. Families who enroll are seeking educational opportunities where their children can learn at school un-shamed for their beliefs at home. Where learning about the God who created order during math class is part of the same school day in which students learn that scientific conclusions not only agree with the Bible but that through the scientific process and logic we can know God better. A school where reading the classics and learning about history helps students learn to learn, reason, and think for themselves today. Knowing Jesus with all our heart, soul, mind and strength throughout all subjects and avenues of life can be lived out at LCA.

We are seeing an increased available to students and families dissatisfaction of government public schools. As we talk with we hear the following



interest in opportunities at LCA in part due to mandated curriculums in families seeking enrollment statements:

"I want my child to be able to grow up in an environment where they are not treated as a bigot because they believe in truth, where acceptance is not excluded from those of the Christian faith, where tolerance is not used as a weapon against morals." "I do not want my child to be forced to refrain from capitalizing their own race to prove that they aren't a racist." "I don't want my child groomed for sexual abuse through required classroom reading." "I want my child to grow up knowing their parents are on their team rather than learning steadily through their schooling years that their parents are misguided and that public education holds a truer path." "I want my child to be able to use a bathroom safely." "I want my children to be able to have the God they believe in an integrated part of every moment of their day, not just someone who is allowed only on evenings and weekends."

It is our prayer that as we grow, more and more Christian families can find what they are looking for in their children's education here at Laramie Christian Academy.
