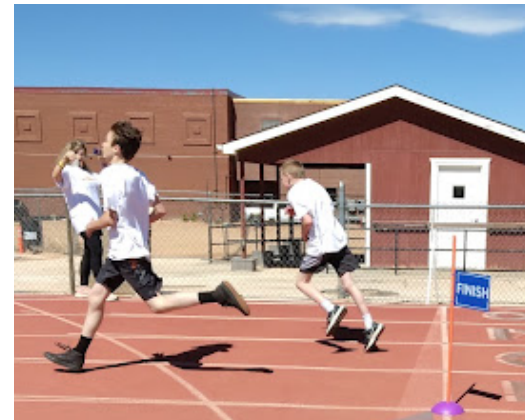
FIELD DAY 2022
