### **WEATHER BALLOON LAUNCH** TAKES LEARNING TO NEW HEIGHTS

On December second (or December ninth if the second is too windy) LCA students will launch a payload of items into the stratosphere. Using a weather balloon equipped with cameras, twelve pounds of items, and a parachute for the landing, LCA students will study the effects of the atmosphere.

Our oldest class will follow the balloon via vehicle to the landing site to recover the items which will be brought back to LCA and observed. The entire flight will be videoed with three camera views and recorded for students to watch. Observations pre and post flight can be used to confirm or deny hypotheses and observe the effect of our atmosphere on matter.

One new family activity LCA started last spring is Donuts with Dad and Muffins with Mom. Moms and Dads are invited to join LCA students in the mornings for a donut or muffin and then participate in our starting routine, prayer and pledge.
