## 10, 080 MEALS IN THREE HOURS!

Excitement was easily felt among students and staff in the morning as we began our packing party with a kiss, a kiss for a pig. That's right, for crossing our $75 \%$ mark, Mrs. McKamey kept her promise and kissed a pig. How did it feel? "Like kissing someone's head with a buzz cut." For part of the fun, she wore a green wig and yellow lipstick. Although the yellow kiss mark did not show up on the pig's snout as hoped, all 40 plus witnesses and multiple photos will attest that the pig was, in fact, kissed in celebration of God's provision through generous donors who supported our students'/families' hard work.


Once the logistics of table assignments were sorted out, students began with enthusiasm to measure the ingredients for the bags. Our teams packed rice and bean meals which also included vitamins and vegetables. Once all the ingredients were measured, each bag was weighed to verify it had enough volume and then sealed. The bags were then packed into a box. Each bag included six meals, and each box held 40 bags. Altogether we packed enough bags to fill 42 boxes for a total of 10,080 !

Students were excited and enthusiastic as they diligently participated, ensuring each bag included the correct measurements. They wanted to be sure the children we packed meals for received everything they were supposed to in each serving. All told, the actual packing took 1.5 hours, with assignment logistics at the beginning and clean-up at the end taking up the remainder of the 3 hours allotted. By 2 pm , the cases of food and box of supplies were picked back up by the shipment company, and all the food was on its
