Classical Christian education is dedicated to raising well-rounded people, and the fine arts play an important role. . . Classical educators understand the importance of truth, beauty, and goodness, and there is no better way to cultivate a

love and appreciation for beauty than by learning to create beauty for oneself.

Music was once considered one of the seven liberal arts, one of the four mathematical subjects in the quadrivium. This is because music theory deals with numerical proportions.

Teaching children to make music, whether with instruments or voices, is a sure-fire way to get them to appreciate it. Learning music when you're young makes for good pitch and rhythm later in life. LCA Dads, Pastor Bobby, and Bloedorn Lumbar donated supplies, tools, and instructional time teaching our older students how to build a Gaga ball Pit. What's Gaga Ball? It originated in Israel and is a ball game played in an octagon or hexagon walled "pit." Dubbed a kinder version of dodge ball, players are out when the ball connects to a player below the knee. The game is played with a soft ball and combines the skills of dodging, striking, running, and jumping. Each round passes quickly, some lasting a minute or less. Once the last person standing wins the round, everyone hops back in for another round. Students of all ages have quickly declared that this is their "favorite game ever" and beg for PE to include Gaga Ball (even after playing it for three recesses straight!).
