UNIFORM

Our new uniforms look amazing! It's clear that team LCA is rising to the occasion and has successfully elevated our game. Thank you to all for your feedback as we implemented the new policy and for your cooperation in helping your LCA students get into their gear! Here are some frequently asked questions regarding our new uniform policy.

Can I wear a sweatshirt/hoodie/fleece of my choice outside? No. All sweatshirts, hoodies, and fleeces are restricted to one of the five style options of navy blue color listed on our Uniforms Pictured guide.

Can I wear a jacket of my choice outside? Yes! At this point there are no restrictions on jackets worn for outdoor weather. Jackets are distinct from sweatshirts/hoodies/and fleeces and may be warn as needed for Laramie weather. (Hoodies, sweatshirts, and fleeces are not considered jackets and may be worn if they are one of the five navy colored options listed on our Uniforms Pictured guide.)

Do skirts have to be pleated? No. The main thing with skirts and shorts is that they are knee length, (with a 2 inch margin of growth -- measured when standing normally from the top of the knee cap) and are one of the approved colors for skirts.

Can skirts be longer than knee length? Yes, not a problem at all.

Can socks be long/tall? Yes. At this point there are no restrictions on socks.

Can I wear colored slacks on Fridays? No. On Fridays in addition to our three colored slack choices (Black, Beige, Navy) we allow jeans of any color/style to be worn (remember no rips/tears/frays, and no skin tight jeans)

What about tops on Free Fridays? Free Fridays now include a Polo of any color choice.

Remember no logos, patterns, etc.
