We started out with what felt like an overwhelmingly high need at an unexpected last minute moment, and here we are, so close to fully funding this year's need.

As I reflect on our journey, I think about the Israelites crossing the Jordan or the Red Sea, as they neared the end and looked back, to see that the space behind them was less than the space in front of them. They were strengthened by knowing how far God brought them and trusting that He would lead all the way; that He who began a good work will be fully able to complete it.

This winter we submitted our documentation for accreditation to the ACCS (the Association of Classical and Christian Schools). They

require five years of documentation across a broad spectrum of academy life. Along with ensuring we are teaching Classically Christian academics, they check to ensure that our school is vital, healthy, and set up the best it can be for longevity and utilizing best practices so we are not vulnerable to shutting down.

One of the areas they look into is our financial stability, and among many other markers, they ask about donor participation -- if any one donation makes up more than 20% of our total operating budget. We are blessed in that LCA has a broad base of donors that give amounts that together add up to a large impact. We are so thankful for you and the part you play in keeping our Academy going strong and spreading the gospel to our children. We remember Jesus' perspective on the widow with her gift of the mite and know that in God's economy your heart behind each gift is what sustains us. Thank you!

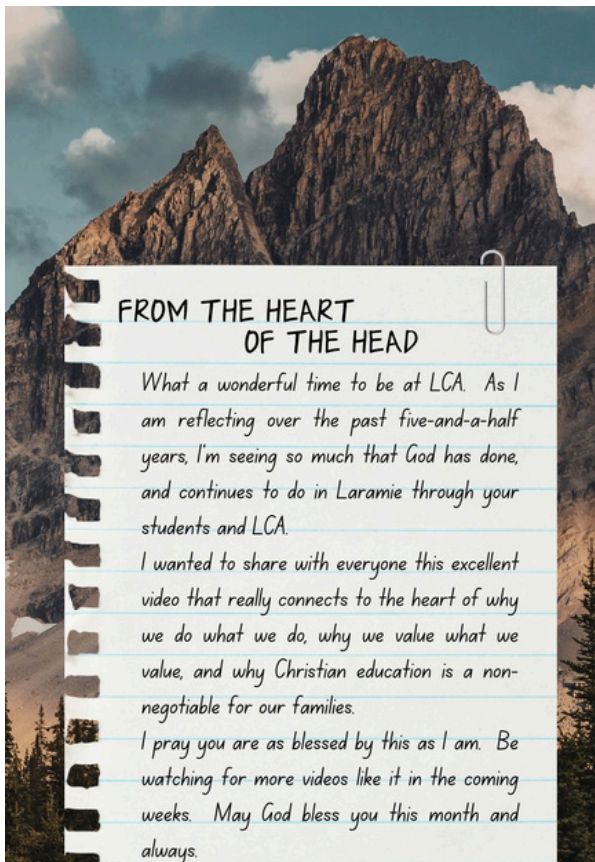
Pray for financial provision for our school to be able to fund our school a year in advance. In future years, we want to award scholarships with funds already received.

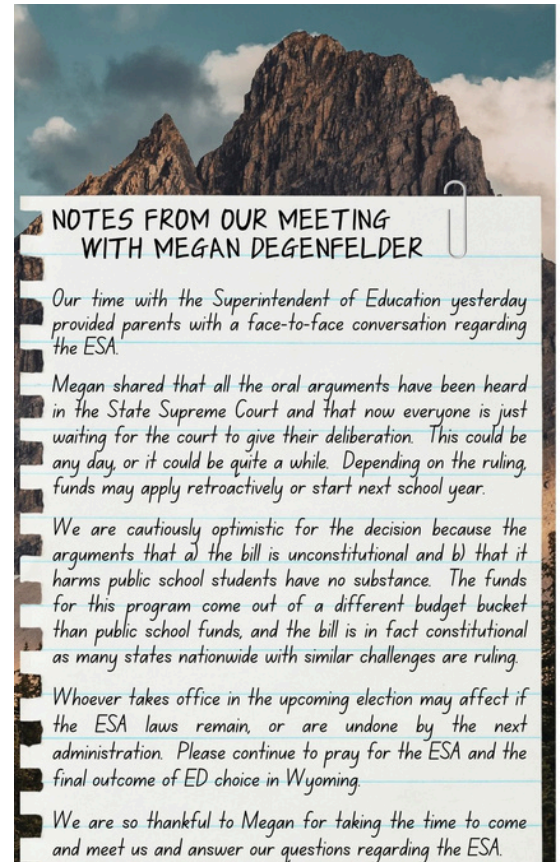

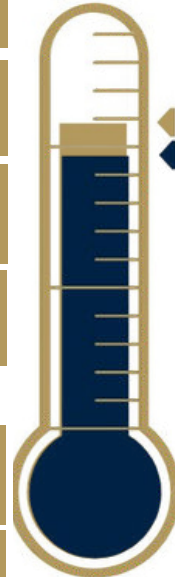
